- An avid doodler and/or artist



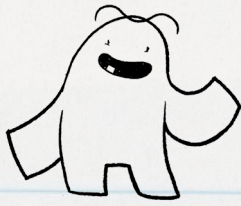
DOODLE-ICIOUS DECORATIONS

Help kids bring their imagination to life by creating one-of-a-kind masterpieces! First, find a table to put markers and paper on to share—the more supplies the better! From funny portraits to serene landscapes, have kids create the kind of artwork they'd like to see in a museum. Once everyone is done, tape the drawings along the walls to see your Doodleville-inspired gallery come to life!

DOODLE-IGHTFUL ACTIVITIES

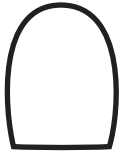




How to Draw Mike the Doodle™ in Five Steps

STEP 1

Draw the body



STEP 2

Add the arms and head.



STEP 3

Give him hair.



STEP 4

Draw the legs.



STEP 5

Finish with eyes and a mouth.



What else can you add to Mike? Doodle your own creations to turn him into a superhero, space explorer, or magical warrior!

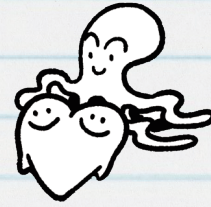




Create Your Own Flipbook

Bring your doodles to life!

1. Grab a sticky notepad and think about what you want to doodle!



2. Keep your illustration simple (think a stick figure or a cloud).

3. Start at the bottom right of the first sticky note (this will be the first image of your flipbook).

4. On the second sheet of the sticky note, draw your doodle in the same area as the previous one, but adjust it slightly.

5. Follow this pattern until you reach the last sticky note, moving your image slightly on each page. Remember not to draw too close to the sticky edge of the sticky notes as that area won't be visible while flipping.

6. Your flipbook is complete! Flip the book and watch your doodles come to life!



Create Your Doodleville Bookmark!

Once you start reading the Doodleville series, you'll need the perfect bookmark! To create your own, simply fill out the frames below with your doodles! Finally, cut along the edges of the bookmark and glue or tape them together!

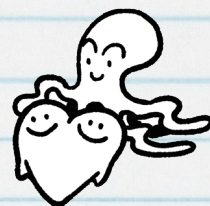
